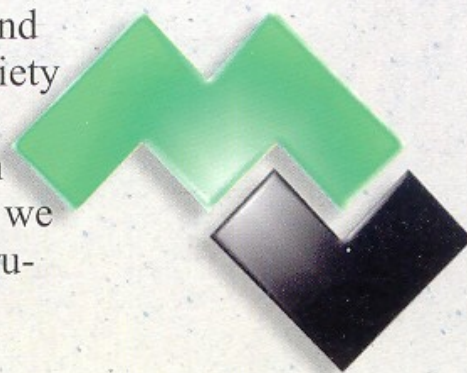


**Other ways of life nowadays:

Meléndez Valdés high school presents the second work contest about science, technology and society for pupils in schools with a bilingual section, as one of the activities which are developed within the CTS work group. This the seventh year that we have carried out this kind of activities, and the rules and regulations are as follow:



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1. The title of the contest is **“Other ways of life nowadays: extinction or continuity”**.
 2. The projects can be written (composition, essay,...), graphic (comic, mural,...) or multimedia (Impress or Powerpoint presentation, video, radio,...) and they must be done in English.
 3. Categories: there will be two categories; the individual category with a digital photo frame and a diploma as the prize, and the second category for groups with a token for sport or educative material and a diploma as a prize for each member. The schools whose pupils participate in this contest by presenting projects, will receive some fun teaching material to help bilingual teaching. The prizes could be declared null and void if the judges consider that the projects aren't of the required level.
 4. The winners will hand in their projects so that they can be published in the magazine “Esbozos”, in the minutes of the CTS meetings, or any other media which “Meléndez Valdés” uses.
 5. The deadline to hand in the projects will be the 31st of March.
 6. The contestants will have to present the projects with a pseudonym. They will enclose the following, a sealed envelope with the name(s) and surnames of the participants, the name of their school and the bilingual teacher(s) who have collaborated.
 7. The projects must be sent to “Meléndez Valdés” High School, in Villafranca de los Barros, specifying that they are for the CTS bilingual contest.
