1. Icebreaker	Intermingle as one group and exchange experiences in common, eg: What's the strangest/best/most horrible food you've ever tried?
2. Introduction to Food Vocabulary	Worksheet to describe tastes/idioms to do with food. Suggestion for the classroom: Blindfold tasting & describing - salty/umami/bitter/sweet/sour
3. Humour does food.	Italian In Malta Clip Wallace & Gromit videos: Do they like cheese?
4. Blindfold tasting for experts only.	Blindfold tasting & describing: A) Texture B) What is it? C) Like/hate/find disgusting?
Celebrations and associated food: Powerpoints of English speaking countries' special days.	Discover new celebrations and/or foods to find new and original ways of studying English speaking cultures.
What's going on here?	Listen to a short video, imagine what's happening, discuss and then see video.
