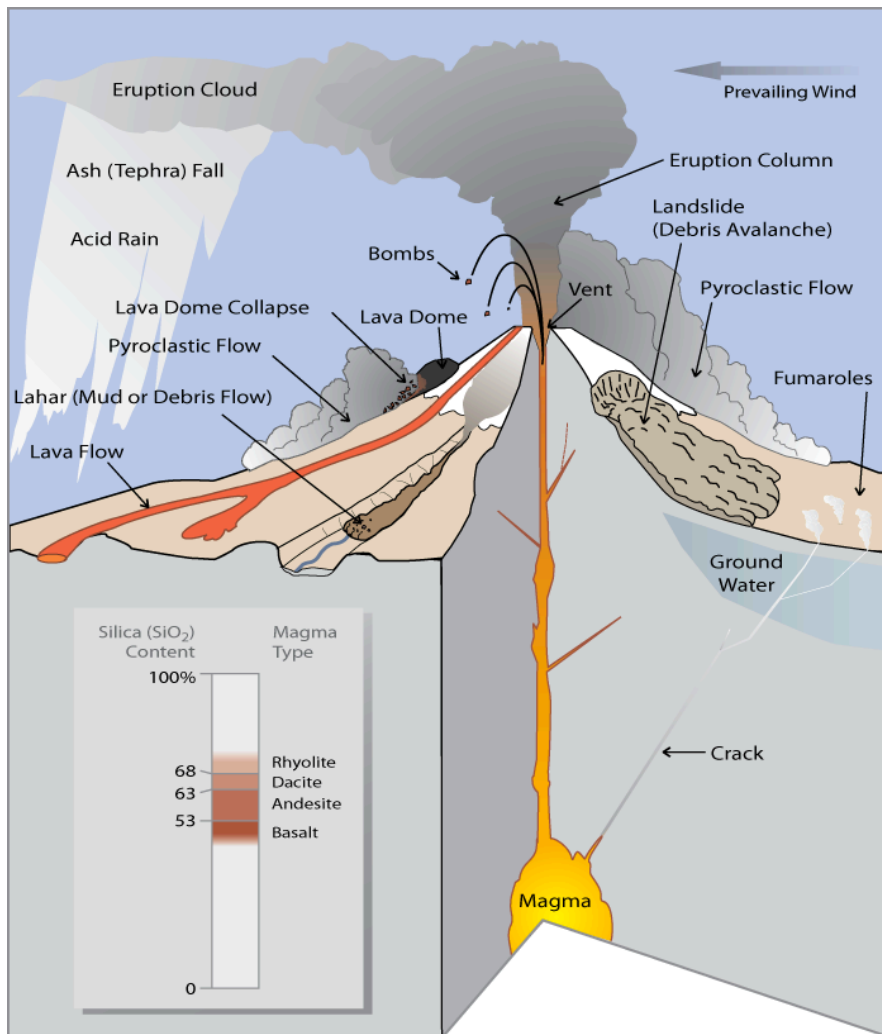


## VOLCANO HAZARDS
